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Content Goal 4

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Complex Systems

Preview

- The whole is greater than the sum of the components.
- The components self-organize through interaction.
- The outcome depends on the initial conditions, and is often unpredictable.

- Is the background explained?
- Is the research question/problem identified and easily understood?
- Is the cost/significance of the question/problem identified *and* convincing?
- Is the response to the question/problem clear and reasonable (within the given time)?
- Does the presentation follow the "research format," i.e.,
 - Introduction (background, problem/significance, response),
 - Body (solution to the problem),
 - Conclusion (results, significance, future).
- Do you have any questions?
- Do you have any suggestions for improvement?
