**Exercise C4, 11/9/04****Critical Review of First Drafts**

**Task:** Read and critically review the drafts assigned to you. Note that the whole point of this exercise is that the authors get helpful feedback and can improve their papers. It is in the best interest of everyone that the reviews be accurate. Since the reviews will only be available on-line anonymously (you must not include hard copies in your evaluation folders), you must be (and can be) as critical as possible. Of course, you are also expected to be able to point out good points where applicable.

**Review foci (for each draft)**

1. Is the research question/problem clearly stated?
2. Is the cost or significance of the research question clearly stated in connection to some practical problem? Is the cost/significance convincing?
3. Does the draft follow the research-paper organization (i.e., Introduction: *background, problem/cost, response*; Conclusion: *results, significance, future*)?
4. Is the response (to the research question) logical and convincing?
5. Are there any assumptions that are *not* generally acceptable?
6. Are there any general issues with writing?
7. Is the draft “good” writing?
8. Questions/comments/suggestions
